MINOR CEI PLAN AMENDMENT

BellSouth Corporation, on behalf of BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (“BellSouth”), hereby publishes this Amendment to BellSouth’s previously posted plan for comparably efficient interconnection (“CEI”) for Internet Access Service (the “Plan”).¹ This amendment more specifically describes certain new service features and functionality which may be offered by BellSouth as part of its Internet Access Services pursuant to the Plan, and adds certain additional telecommunications services which BellSouth’s ISP operations may obtain from its regulated telecommunications network and use for the provision of its Internet Access Services pursuant to the Plan.

The Plan is hereby amended to add the following additional category of services to the description of services set forth in Section II of the Plan (immediately following the paragraph captioned “Protocol conversion and network management”):

Voice Applications - a variety of VOIP (Voice Over Internet Protocol) and other voice and related communications applications utilizing or incorporating Internet access and/or IP-related technology, including but not limited to BellSouth® Unified Communications Service, which may provide one or more of the following functions or features: any distance voice communications; voicemail; protocol conversions; integrated directory; unified messaging; converged e-mail; instant messaging; voice, video and/or data

conferencing and collaboration; and converged network solutions incorporating voice, video and/or data transport and Internet access over multiple possible transport type access links; and BellSouth® Enhanced Business Service, which consists of browser-based software and related IP server-based functionality, including IP-based messaging services, that assists the end user with call management and productivity functions when used in conjunction with BellSouth® Centrex IP Service, linking desktop applications and IP-enabled phone devices to help improve worker productivity by letting them use a computer and graphic interface to manage voice calls, access incoming and outgoing call history, and integrate an organization's directories, email, voicemail, telephone systems, and other information.

The following tariffed service is added to the list of such services that may be utilized by BellSouth and by any other ESP/ISP or its customers in the same manner as BellSouth uses them in the offering of its Internet Access Services pursuant to the Plan:
